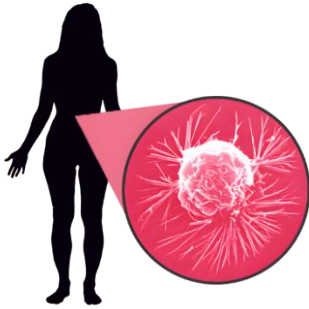


Cancer screening programmes for adults



The NHS cancer screening programmes can help to see if you have cancer, or are at the risk of getting cancer, earlier – this is when it's easier to treat



This leaflet is about the free NHS lung cancer screening programme



If you are registered with a GP practice you will be invited to the screening programme when you reach the right age



You can talk to your GP or health professional about any of the screening programmes

Lung cancer screening



Lung cancer screening can help find lung cancer early, before you have symptoms



A lung health check involves a phone questionnaire and if needed, you may be offered a CT scan



Screening every **2** years for people aged **55** to **74** who smoke or used to smoke



If you're aged **55** to **74** and your GP records show that you smoke or used to smoke, you will get an invitation letter by post



If you think you should have a lung screening, but do not get a letter, call the Lung Cancer Screening Service on
