



Your information

We need information about you so that we can



- give you the right help at the right time



- keep you and other people safe



- check up on services and deal with complaints



- prevent fraud



You don't have to give us your information if you don't want to

If we do not have this information we may not be able to give you the help you need



Other people may share your information with us, for example

- family members and friends



- the NHS



- support organisations



- other local councils



- the Police



We may share your information with other people if and when the law says we can



Your social worker can tell you more about this



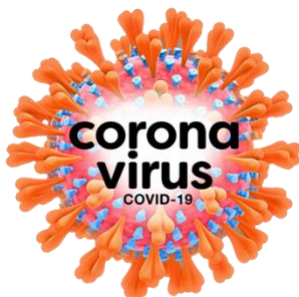
If there is no legal reason for us to share your information but we think it might help you if we do, we will ask you first



Sometimes we may share your information without checking with you first



We will only do this when it is important in order to protect you or other people from harm



As part of our response to the Covid pandemic, we share your information with the Government, the NHS and other organisations



Research groups can sometimes ask for data from us that may include your information



If you do not want researchers to use your data, please contact camdencarechoices@camden.gov.uk

or speak to someone you know in the Council



The law says we must keep your records for 7 years
