



ADULT FAMILY GROUP CONFERENCE

An Adult Family Group Conference (FGC) is an opportunity for adults to meet with the people who care about them and can help them to make important decisions.

Family looks different to everyone. An adult may want to invite supportive people in their life; including friends, family or members of their local community.

A Family group conference is organised and run by an independent FGC Coordinator.

What if I agree to take part in the FGC:

Before the day of the FGC the FGC Coordinator will support the family and network and prepare them for what will happen at the meeting.

At the FGC meeting, the aim is for the adult and their network to write down their plan of support.

At the Family Group Conference

Part 1

You get the information you need to make a family plan.

A professional, or whoever suggested the FGC, can explain why they are worried and tell you the sort of help that they can offer.

With your friends and family, you will have lots of chances to ask questions and be clear what happens next.

Part 2 - Private FGC time

All professionals (information givers) will then leave the meeting. The adult with their network will have their own time to make their plan in response to the information shared.

Professionals will leave the room and adult with their network will have their own time to make their plan in response to information shared.

When the adult and network have made their plan, professionals will return to join them.

Part 3 - Explaining your plan

Everyone will sit together again. The adult's network will share their plan with the professionals.

The plan will be agreed as long as what it says is needed and is safe for everyone involved.

The Coordinators:
